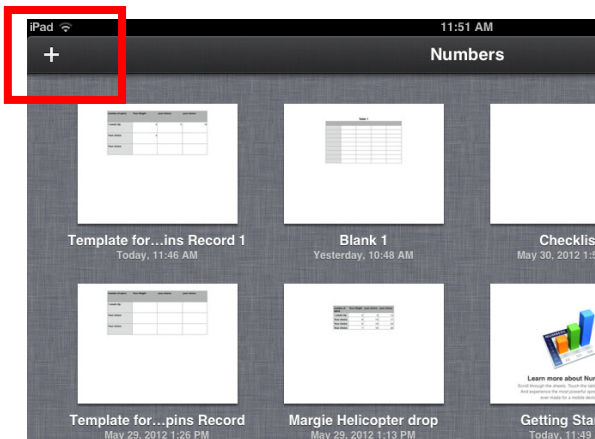


# How to create a chart from a Table in Numbers on the iPad 2

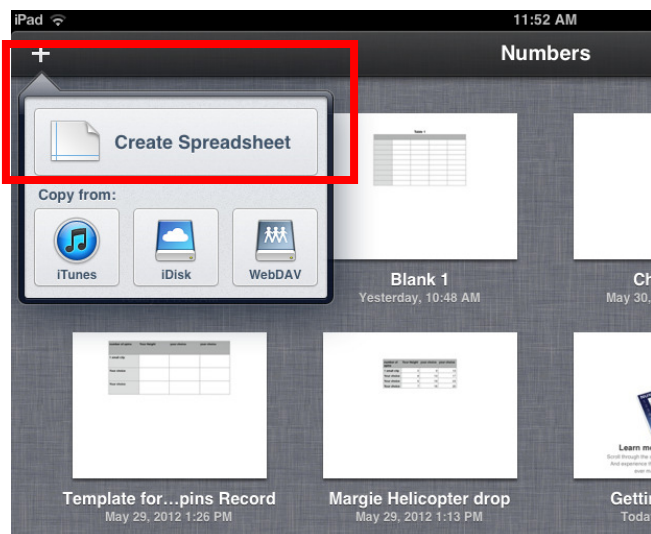
Open the Numbers app



Click the + sign in the top left corner for a new spreadsheet



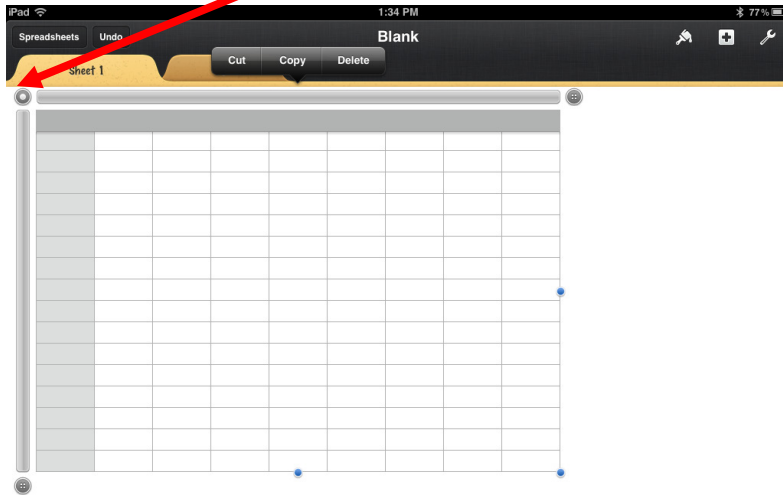
Click Create Spreadsheet



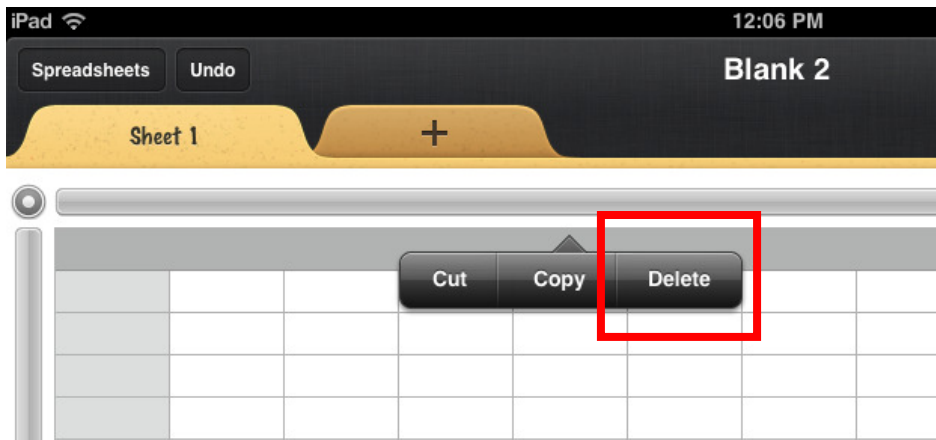
Click the blank Template

Touch the middle of the spreadsheet to select it.

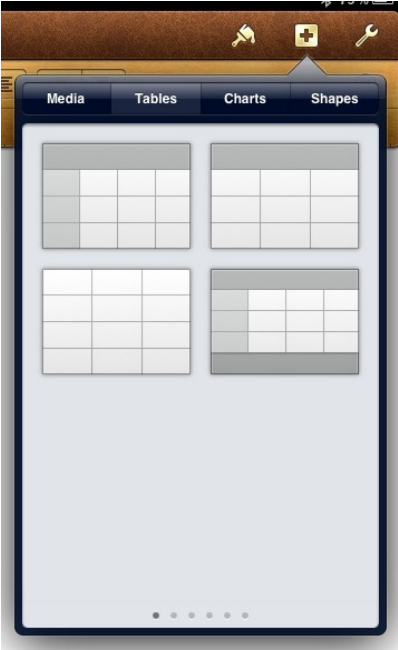
Touch the button on the top left corner to get a menu



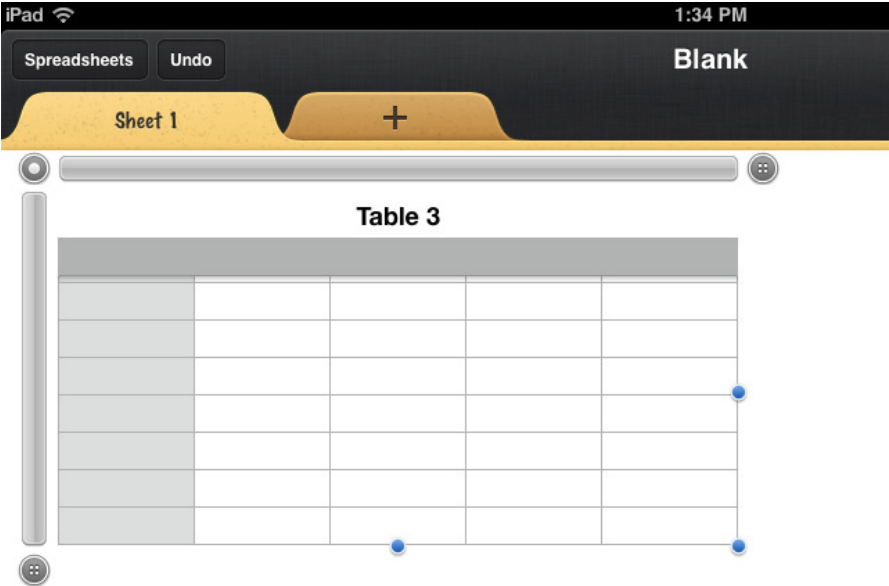
Choose Delete from the menu to get a clear page




Select the + sign in the top right corner, then the Tables tab.



Your table will appear in the workspace



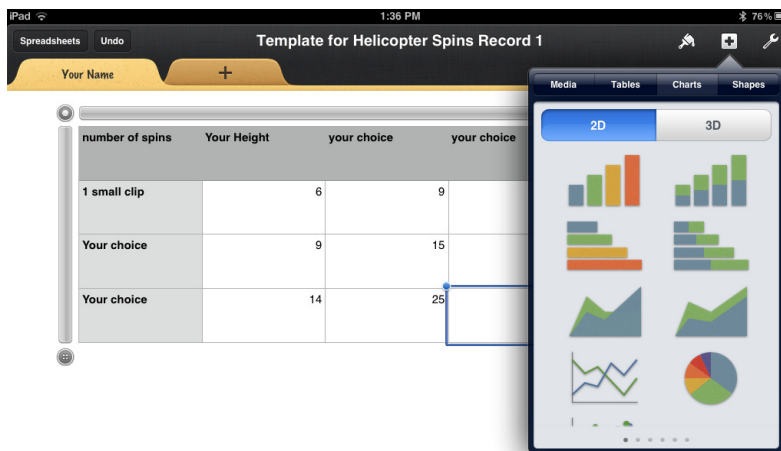
When the data is in your table it may look like this

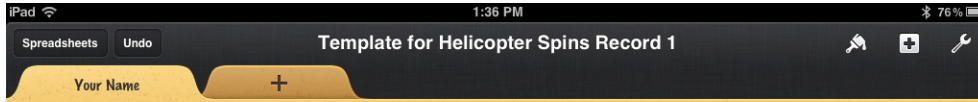

Select the + sign in the top right corner, then the charts tab.

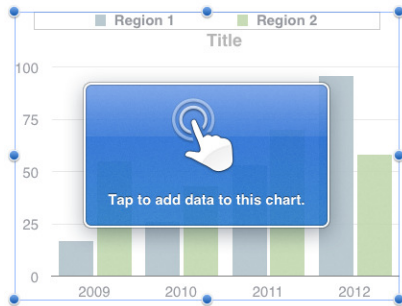


Select the Chart you want by tapping it

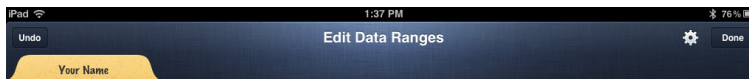
Then tap the middle of the blue circle in the chart box.



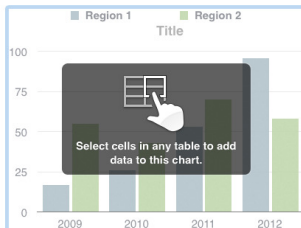

Select the cells in your table that you want to show on your chart.



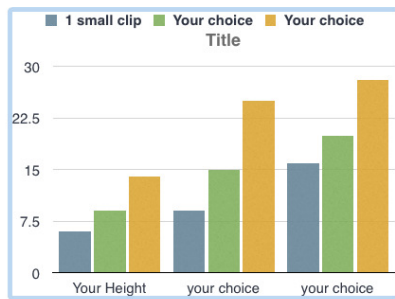
